United States. 'When I Die, They'll Send Me Home. Youth Sentenced to Life without Parole in California'

National, United States - There are 227 inmates in California sentenced as juveniles to life in prison without parole. The International Juvenile Justice Observatory (IJJO) highlights the report 'When I Die, They'll Send Me Home. Youth Sentenced to Life without Parole in California' by Human Rights Watch.



The Juvenile Life Without Parole Reform Act (SB 999) is scheduled for a vote in the State Senate before January 31, 2008. Human Rights Watch's research in California and across the country has found that youth are sentenced to life without parole for a wide range of crimes and culpability and not for the worst crimes committed by minors. In fact, 45 percent of youth who had been sentenced to life without parole had not actually committed the murder.

United Kingdom. 'Young offenders Survey'

National, United Kingdom - 'Young offenders Survey' is the title of a recent survey carried out in the United Kingdom by ICM Research for the organisation 'Prison Reform Trust'. According to the analysis of these statistics, two in three people of over 1000 British polled, think prisons without educational measures are 'universities of crime' and that they are not an efficient resource for the prevention of juvenile delinquency.



This research reveals the nature of the British public's opinion concerning the measures that are applied to young offenders. They mainly think that the development of preventive and community measures as well as educational activities are more important than punitive and prison strategies for minors in conflict with the law. In fact, the public opinion has not become tougher towards
