With this proposal in mind, the IJJO presents the **IJJO GLOSSARY** of terms and concepts in juvenile justice, with definitions taken from official international sources in each of the three official languages of the IJJO: English, French and Spanish.

This resource was developed with the goal of collecting together those terms which form part of the jargon most commonly used by professionals and actors involved in juvenile justice, thus being a practical and useful tool which aims to facilitate a greater comprehension and understanding of the concepts that define the different juvenile justice systems on an international level.
